Objective and Investment Policy

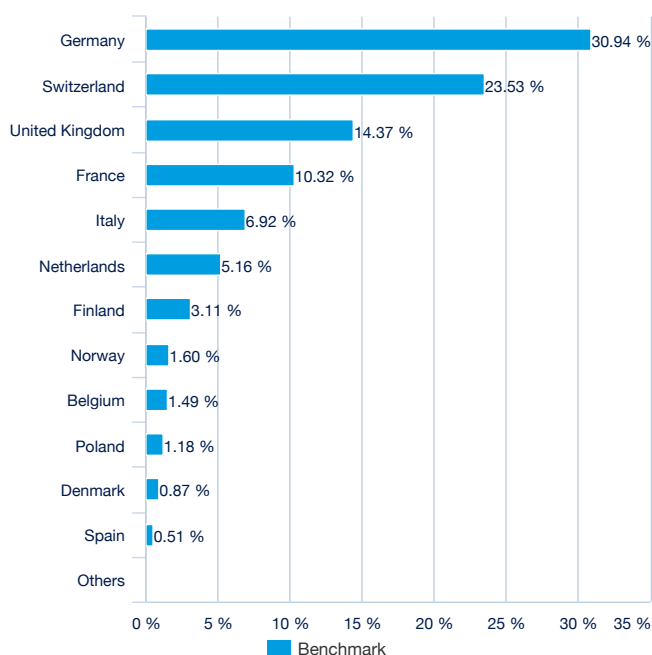

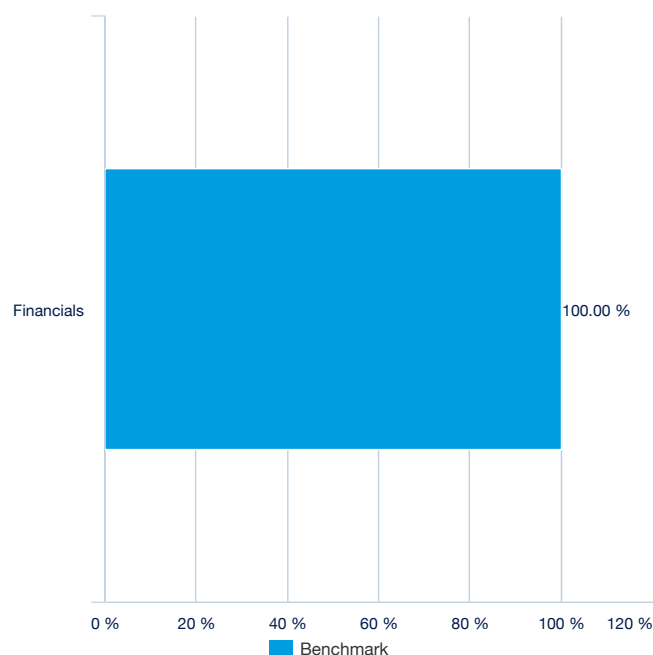
