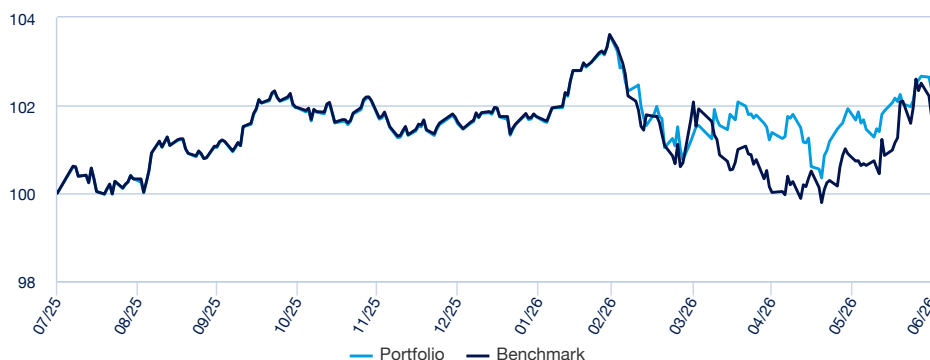

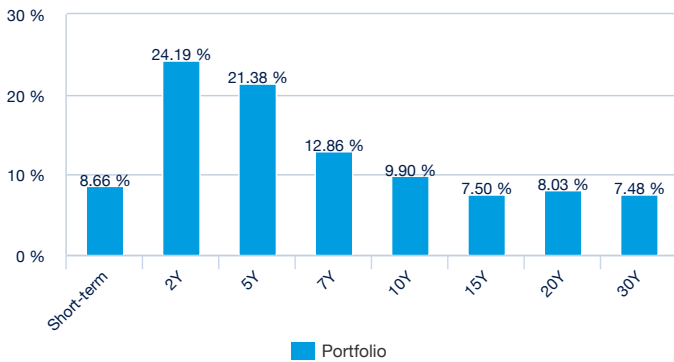

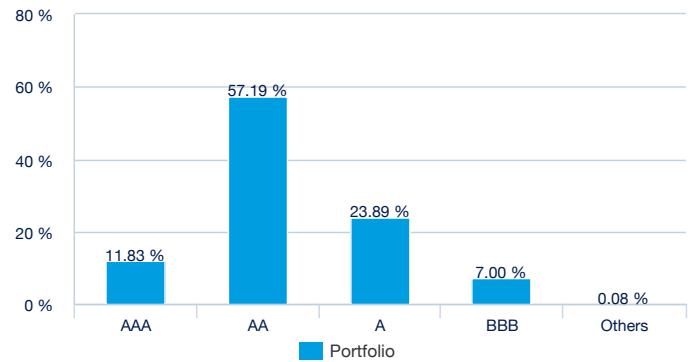

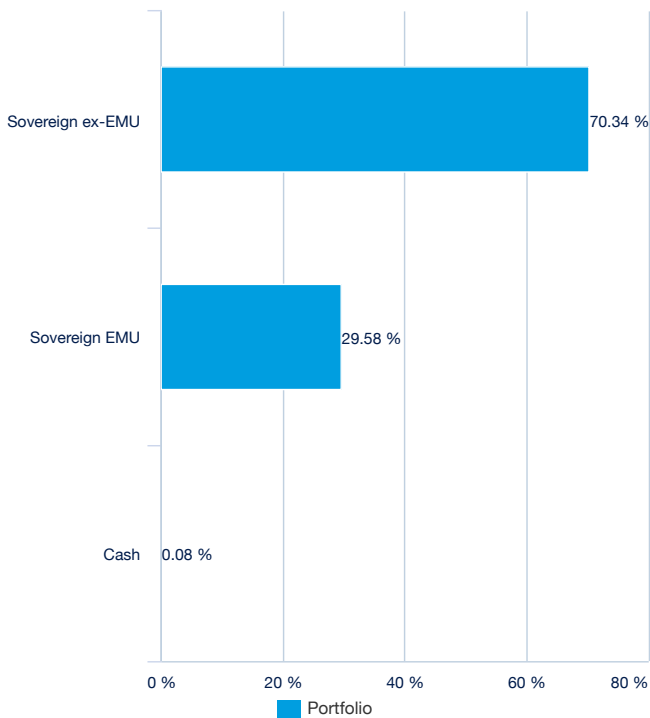
By maturity (Source: Amundi)



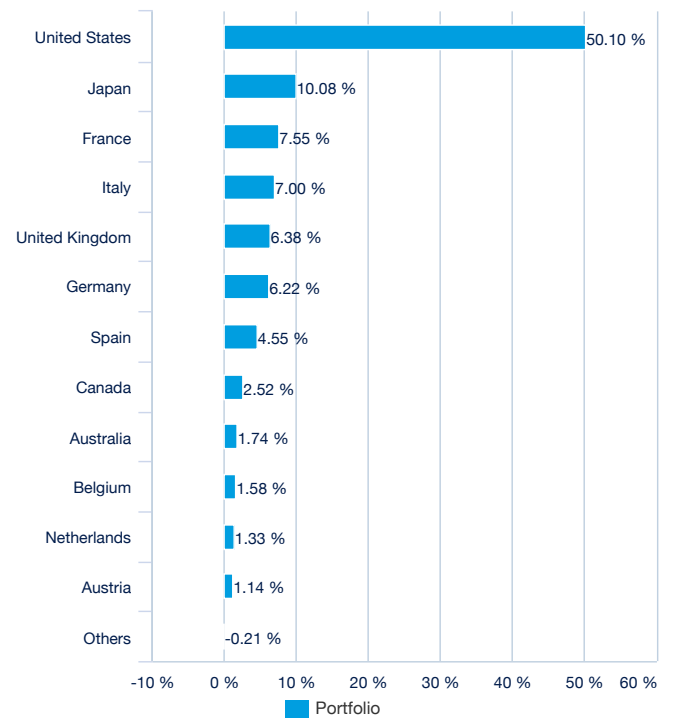
