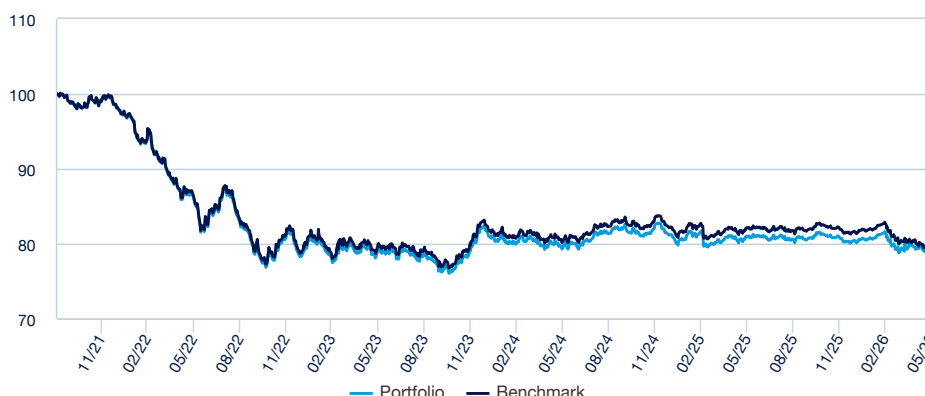

Objective and Investment Policy

The Amundi Green Bond (DR) UCITS ETF - Monthly Hedged to CHF - Acc aims to track the Solactive Green Bond EUR USD IG Index, a benchmark of EUR and USD denominated investment-grade green bonds issued by sovereigns, supranationals, development banks and corporates. The CHF-hedged share class offers the simplicity of a monthly currency hedge mechanism that is embedded in the investment product, representing an efficient solution to manage the foreign-exchange risk.

CAPITAL AT RISK : ETFs are tracking instruments: Their risk profile is similar to a direct investment in the Underlying Index. Investors' capital is fully at risk and investors may not get back the amount originally invested.

REPLICATION RISK : The fund objectives might not be reached due to unexpected events on the underlying markets which will impact the index calculation and the efficient fund replication.

COUNTERPARTY RISK : Investors are exposed to risks resulting from the use of an OTC Swap with MORGAN STANLEY BANK AG, SOCIETE GENERALE. In-line with UCITS guidelines, the exposure to the counterparty cannot exceed 10% of the total fund assets. Physically replicated ETFs may have counterparty risk resulting from the use of a Securities Lending Programme.

UNDERLYING RISK : The Underlying Index of a Amundi ETF may be complex and volatile. When investing in commodities, the Underlying Index is calculated with reference to commodity futures contracts exposing the investor to a liquidity risk linked to costs such as cost of carry and transportation. The Solactive Green Bond EUR USD IG Index, a benchmark of EUR and USD denominated investment-grade green bonds issued by sovereigns, supranationals, development banks and corporates Green bonds are fixed income securities whose proceeds are solely dedicated to the financing of eligible green projects focused on climate mitigation or adaptation efforts. The index constituents are labelled green bonds defined as eligible for index inclusion by the Climate Bonds Initiative, an independent not-for-profit organisation dedicated to the promotion of investments for a low carbon and climate-resilient economy.

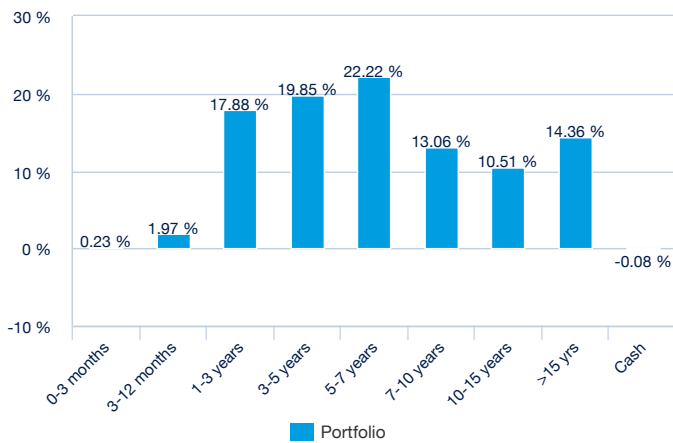

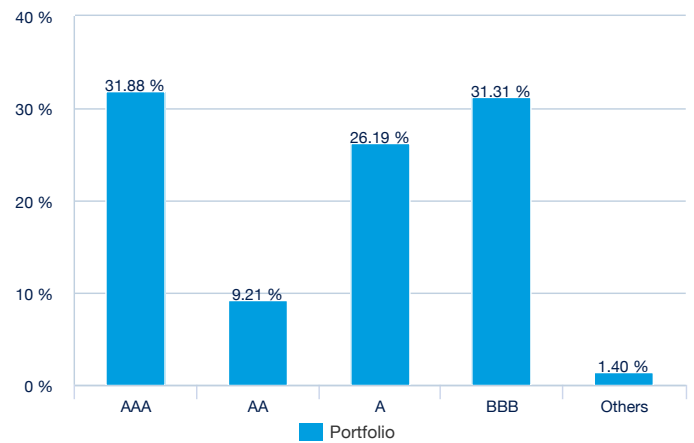

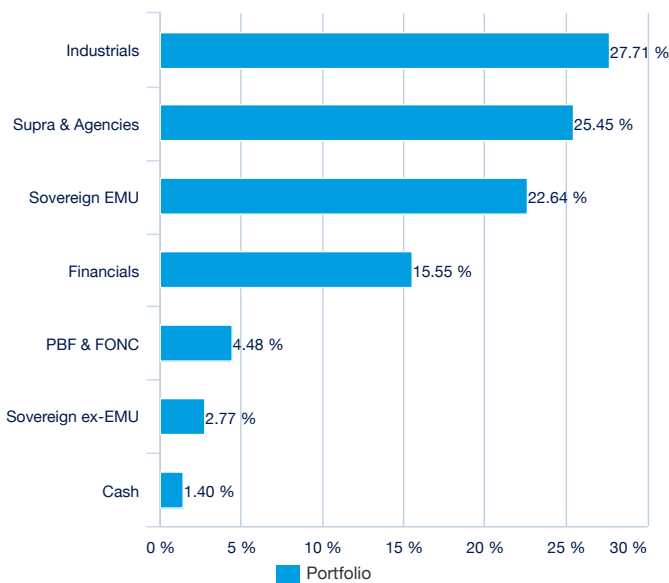
By maturity (Source: Amundi)



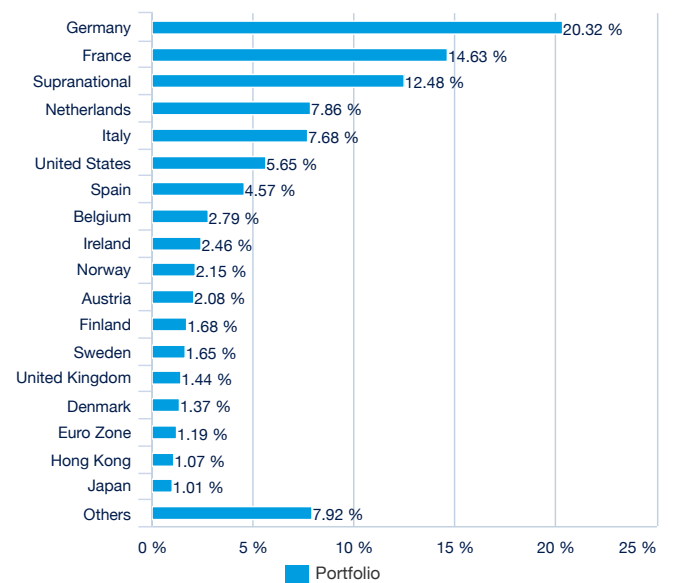
